To be Human, although a relatively short piece of music, I believe I managed to sum up my idea. The greater idea of what being human means. Our nature. To top that idea off, if only listened to with more than the ear, the great conclusion to it all has, in the darkness of it all, a hint of malicious, that in the real world is surrounding us all. Corruption, War, conflict, and death. What It means to be a society. The majority of the composition is filled with thunderous sounds bouncing off one another causing more and more to fall as more and more is added. It is a simple and similar way of music to many pieces in the cinematic world of music, and modelling from this brings me that ability to strike emotion in the interpreter. The contrast in segments of the piece and the thought of story throughout not only has helped to guide me as the producer when in producing but to also carry the listener with the sound as they create their own story in their own head. And going once again to the conclusion of the song, it can almost bring a chill to your soul as the final notes wrap up and bring a realization moment causing the listener to reflect and reconcile on their own story.
